



TEACHING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE KEEP SAFE SKILLS

This one-day workshop will focus on teaching children and young people 'keep safe' skills following allegations of sexual abuse or sexual exploitation. The workshop is aimed at practitioners who work in a variety of settings including health, social services, youth offending teams, education and the voluntary sector.

The workshop will explore the following areas:

- What do we mean by keep safe skills?
- Practical exercises which can be undertaken with children and young people in order to help them develop appropriate skills to reduce their risk of further abuse or exploitation
- Developing a family safety plan with Parents and Carers
- Helping Parents and Carers understand the importance of keep safe skills for children and young people

The day will consist of tutor input, experiential exercises, group discussions and handouts.
